



# Federal Salmon Management in the Upper Cook Inlet

Northern Marine Fisheries Service (NMFS) proposes Amendment 16 to the Fishery Management Plan for the Salmon Fisheries in the Exclusive Economic Zone (EEZ)

If approved, Amendment 16 and this proposed rule would **establish Federal fishery management for all salmon fishing that occurs in the Cook Inlet EEZ**, including commercial drift gillnet and recreational salmon fishery sectors

# **Commission Goals**

Maintain and enhance the Conservation Corridor in the drift gillnet fishery management plan.

Continue conservative management practices which provide protection for current and formerly identified Stocks of Concern.


Increase in-river returns of Coho salmon to Northern Cook Inlet river systems.
